New for 2012 is the way in which we are inviting you to join us in caring for our estate and gardens here at Scargill. We have decided to introduce the idea of a working holiday, where folk come and work on the estate for part of their stay with us but also have plenty of time to relax.



During a mid-week working holiday mornings would be spent working hard outside with opportunities to join other guests for the afternoon and evening programme. Weekends would include a full day out on the estate on Saturday, and freedom to join in with whatever is on offer on Saturday evening and Sunday morning. The cost will be half that of a normal programme, reflecting then new mix of work and leisure.

Volunteers

We are building a wonderful database of volunteers who love to join us as part of our wider community to work in the grounds, the gardens, kitchen or house. We genuinely cannot function without them. If you are interested in becoming a volunteer then please contact us to discuss it further. 
